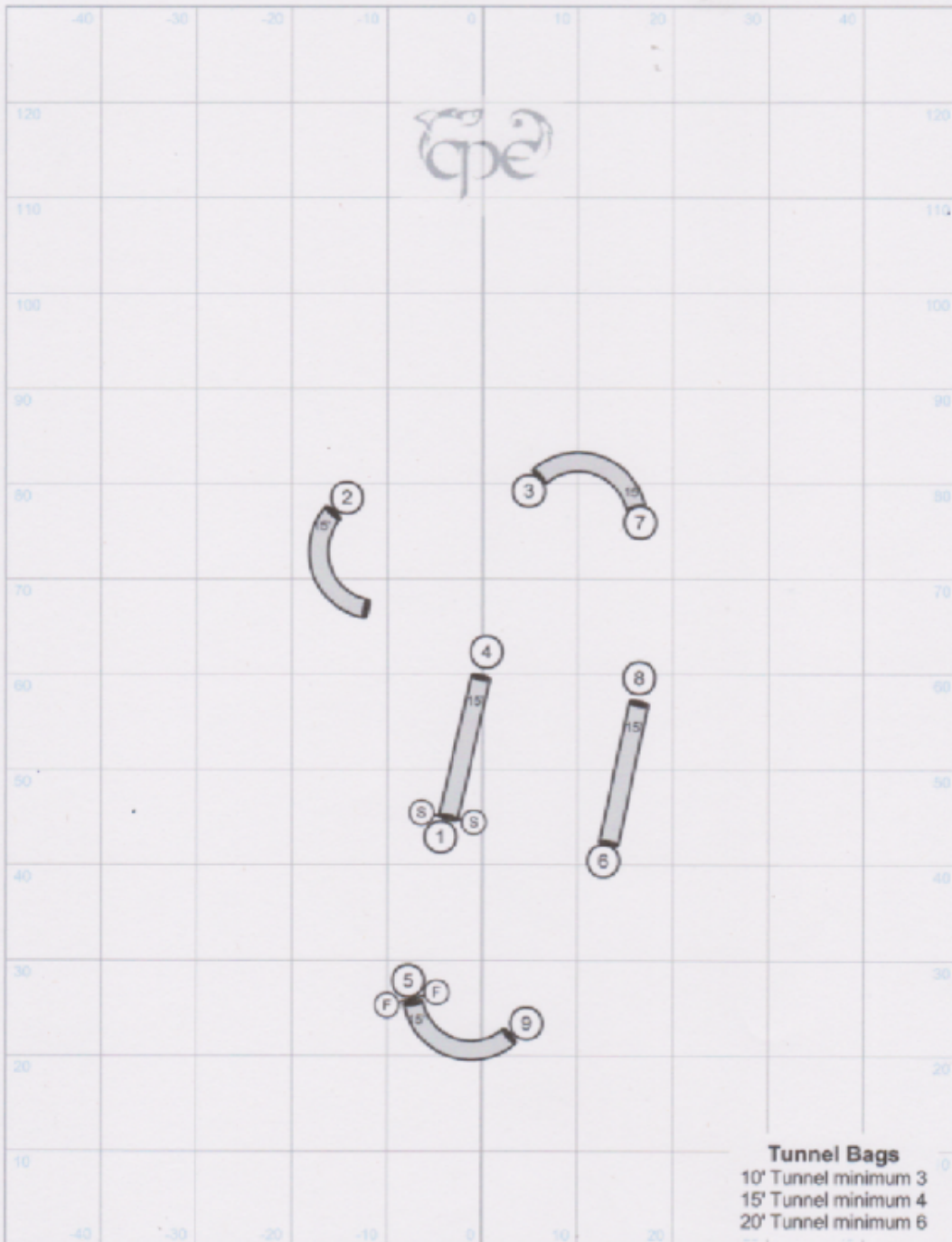


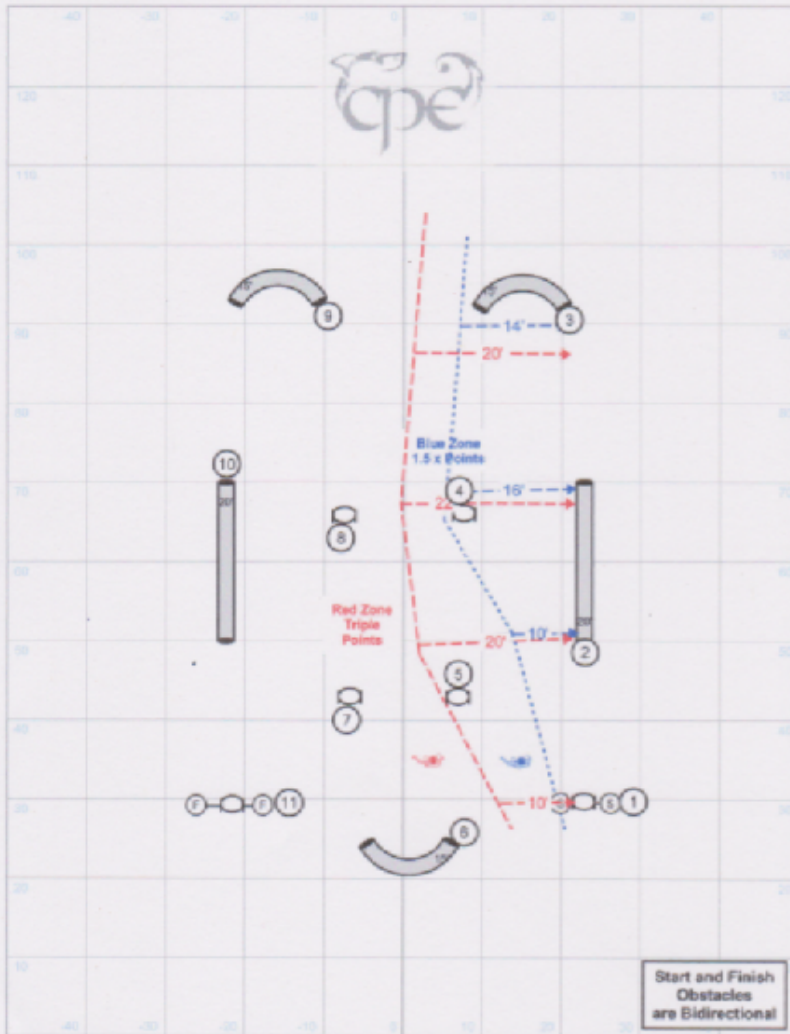

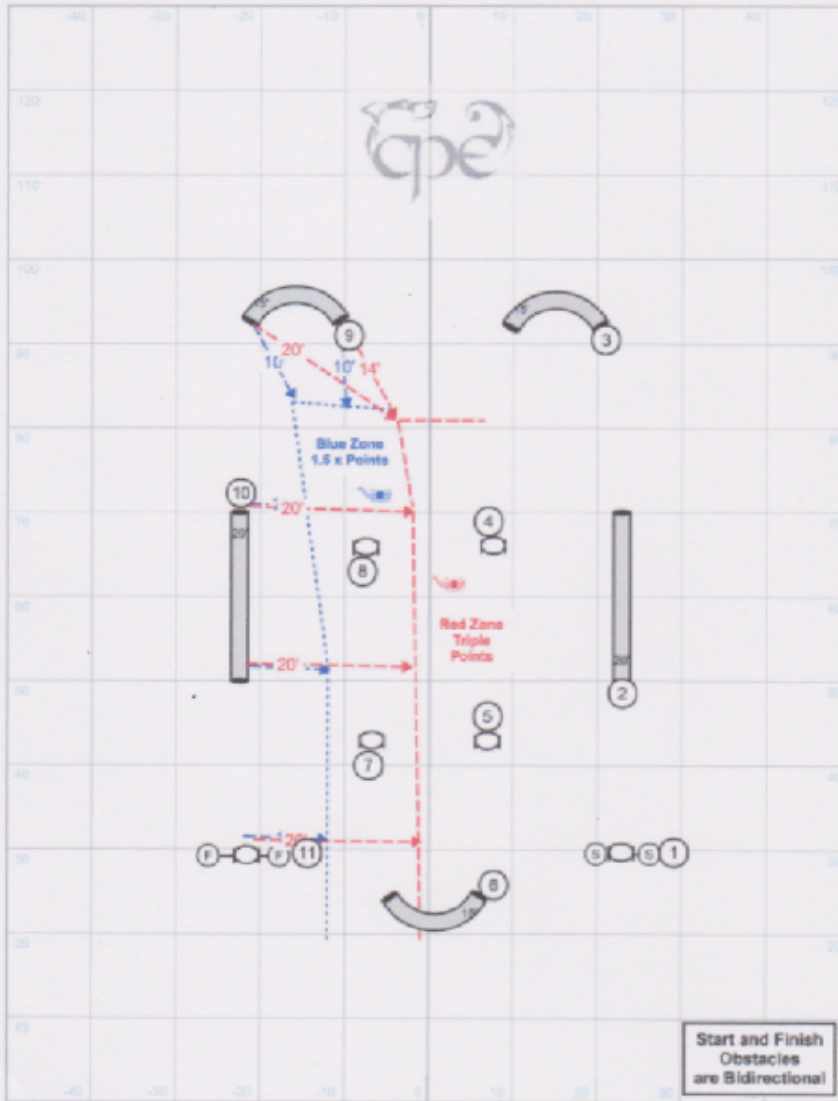

Lateral Challenge
 Handler must stay behind Blue or Red line while the dog completes the required obstacles to get a multiplier! In order to attain the 3X multiplier the handler must stay behind the Red Line while the dog performs obstacles 1-5 as marked on the map. In order to attain the 1.5X multiplier the handler must stay behind the Blue Line while the dog performs obstacles 2-4 as marked on the map.

In addition, all obstacles on the course must be performed without any required corrections to qualify with a multiplier. Obstacle corrections allow for a score but in that case the multiplier is voided.

Handlers may choose to run the entire path with their dog for no multiplier.

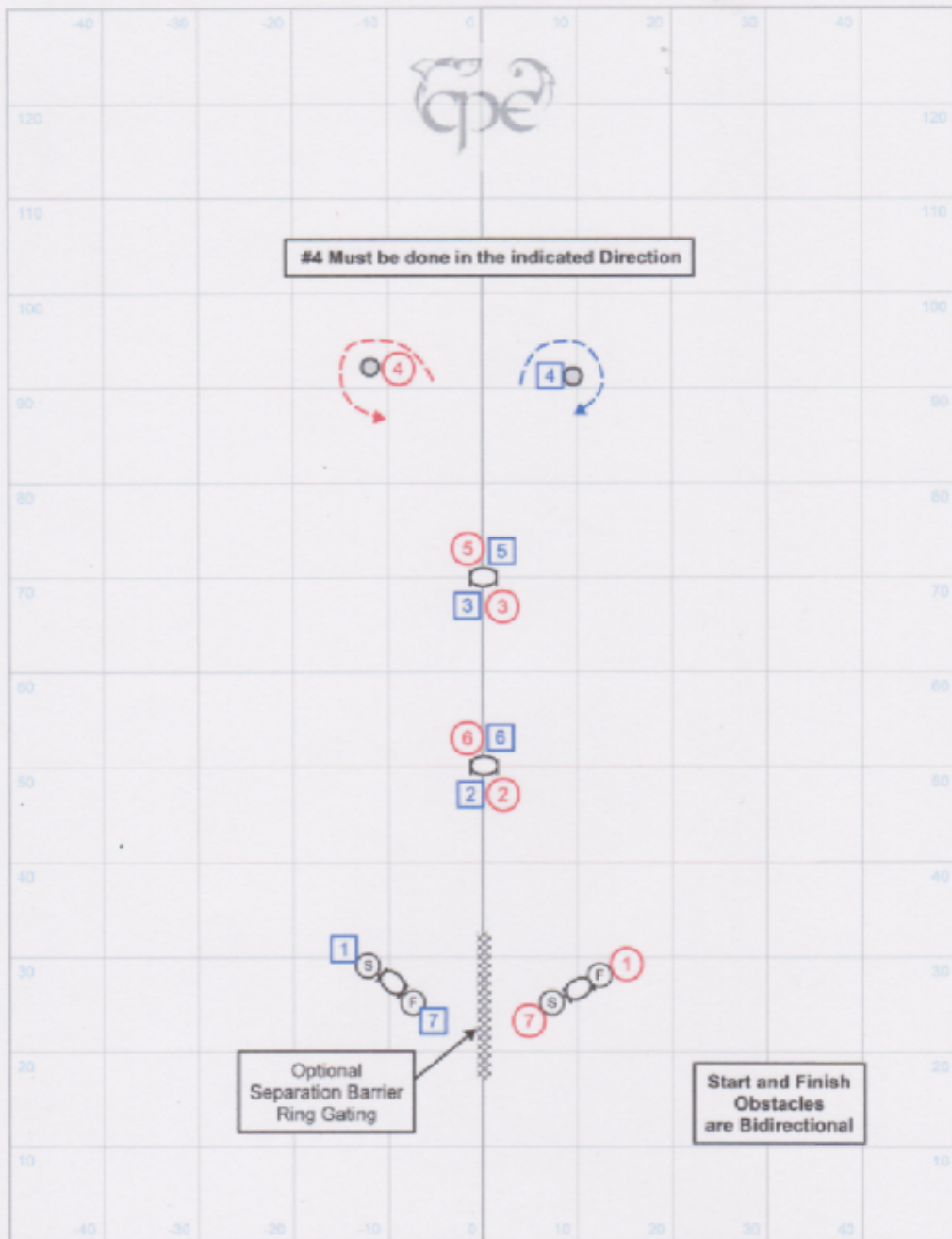


Slingshot 2 & 3

In addition, all obstacles on the course must be performed without any required corrections to qualify with a multiplier. Obstacle corrections allow for a score but in that case the multiplier is voided.

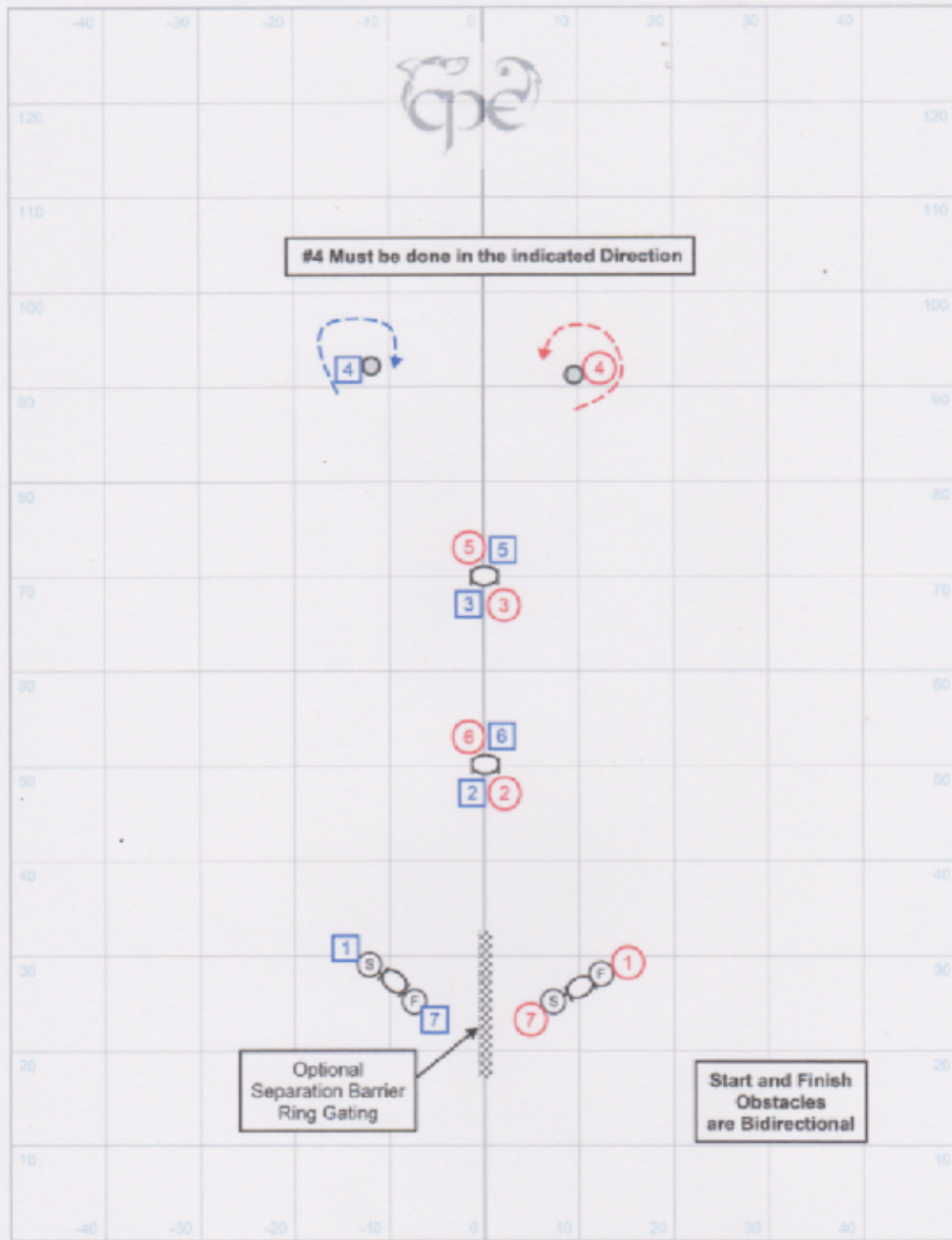


Hairpin Team 1
